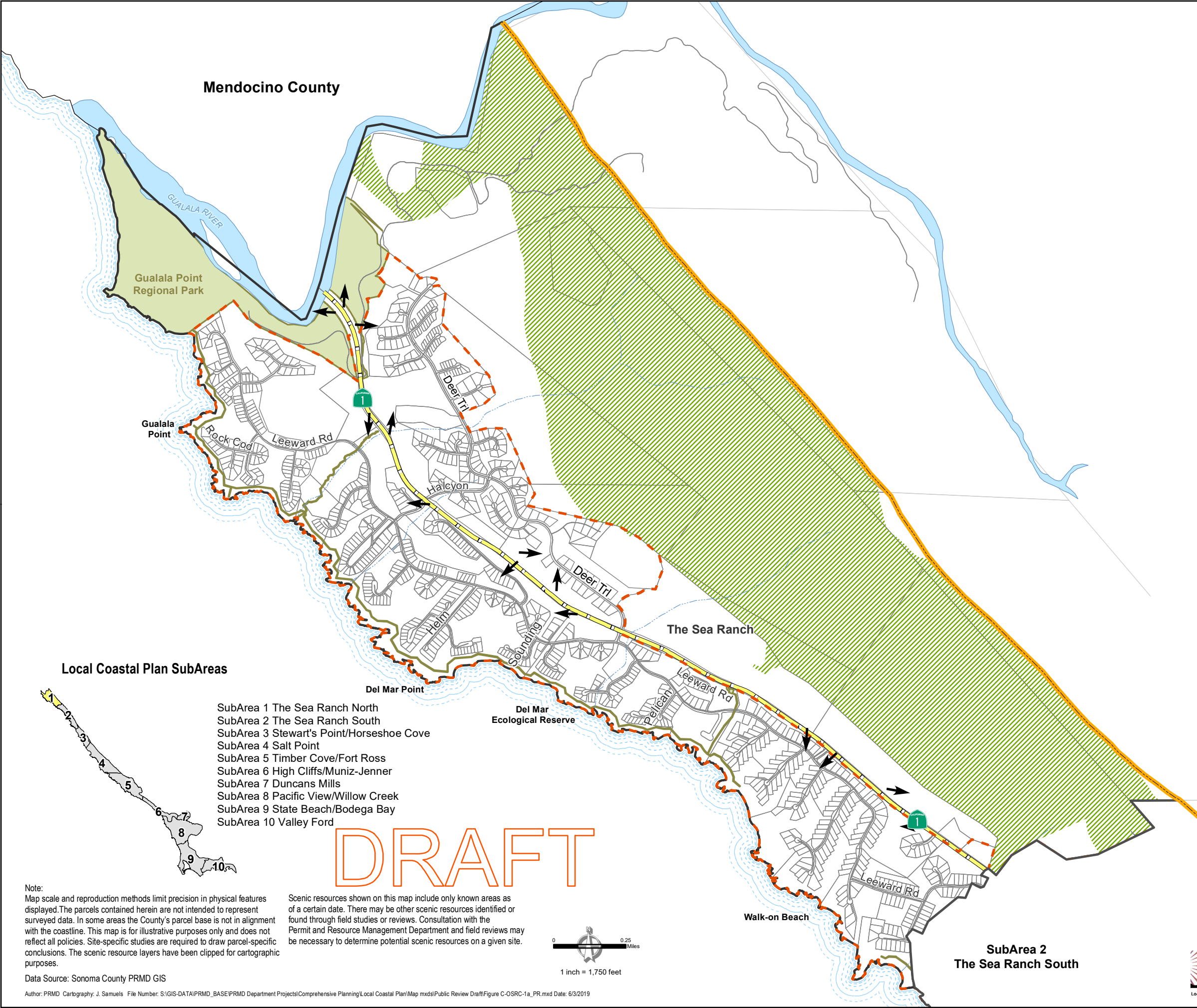

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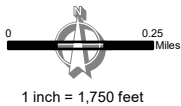


FIGURE C-OSRC-1a

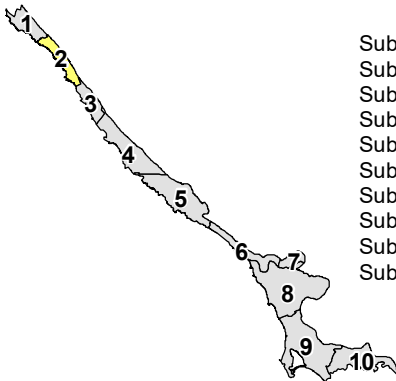

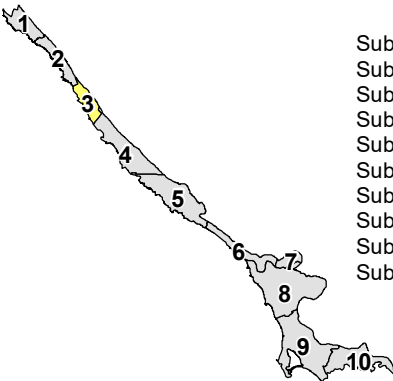

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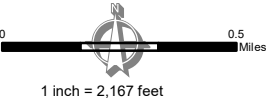

Stewarts Point/Horseshoe Cove

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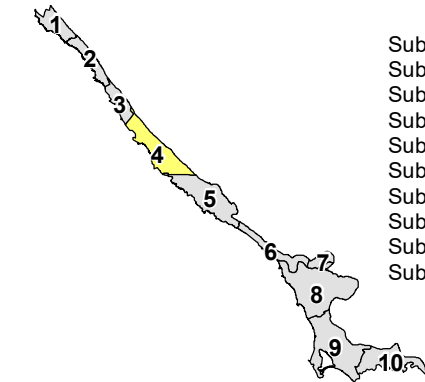

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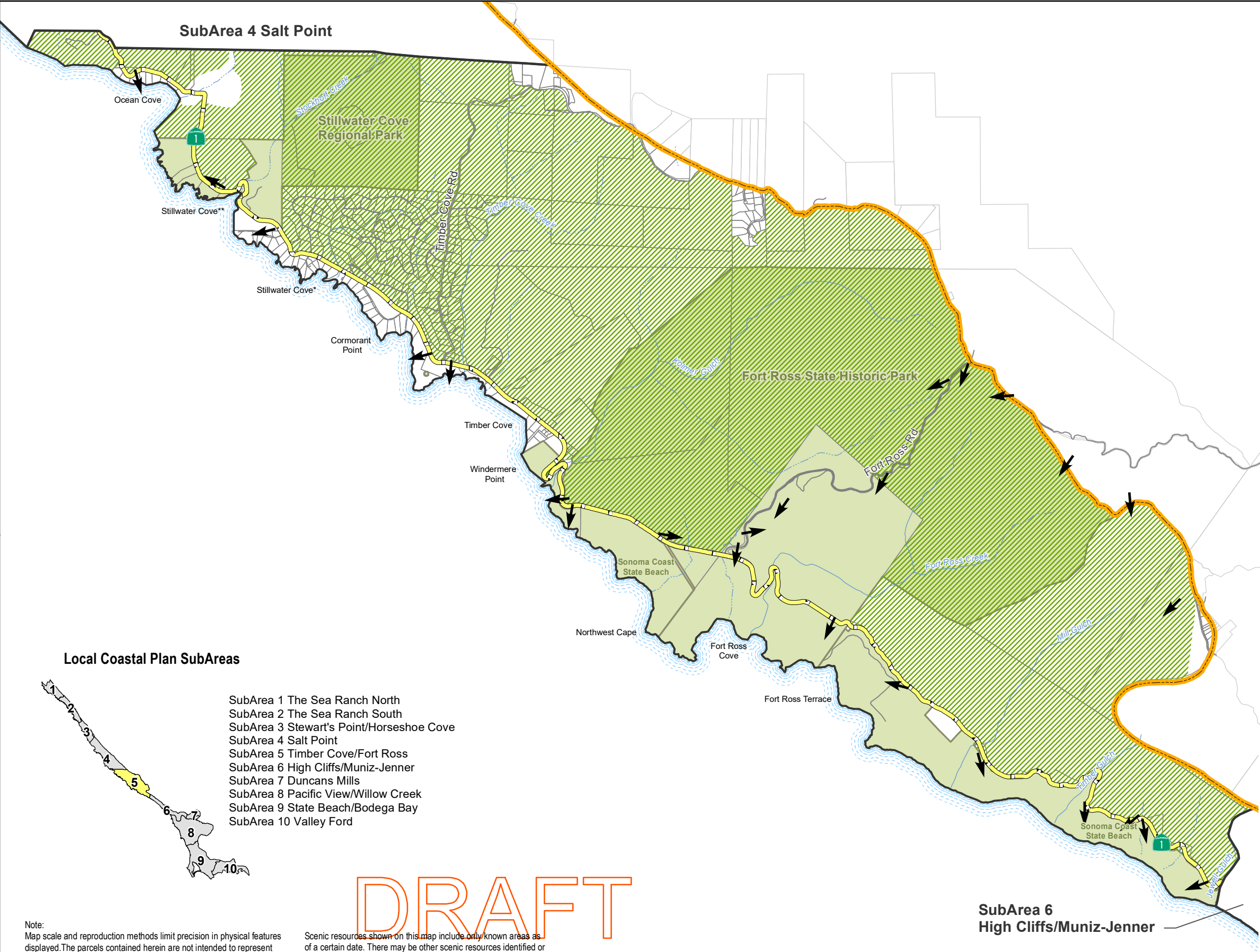


FIGURE C-OSRC-1d

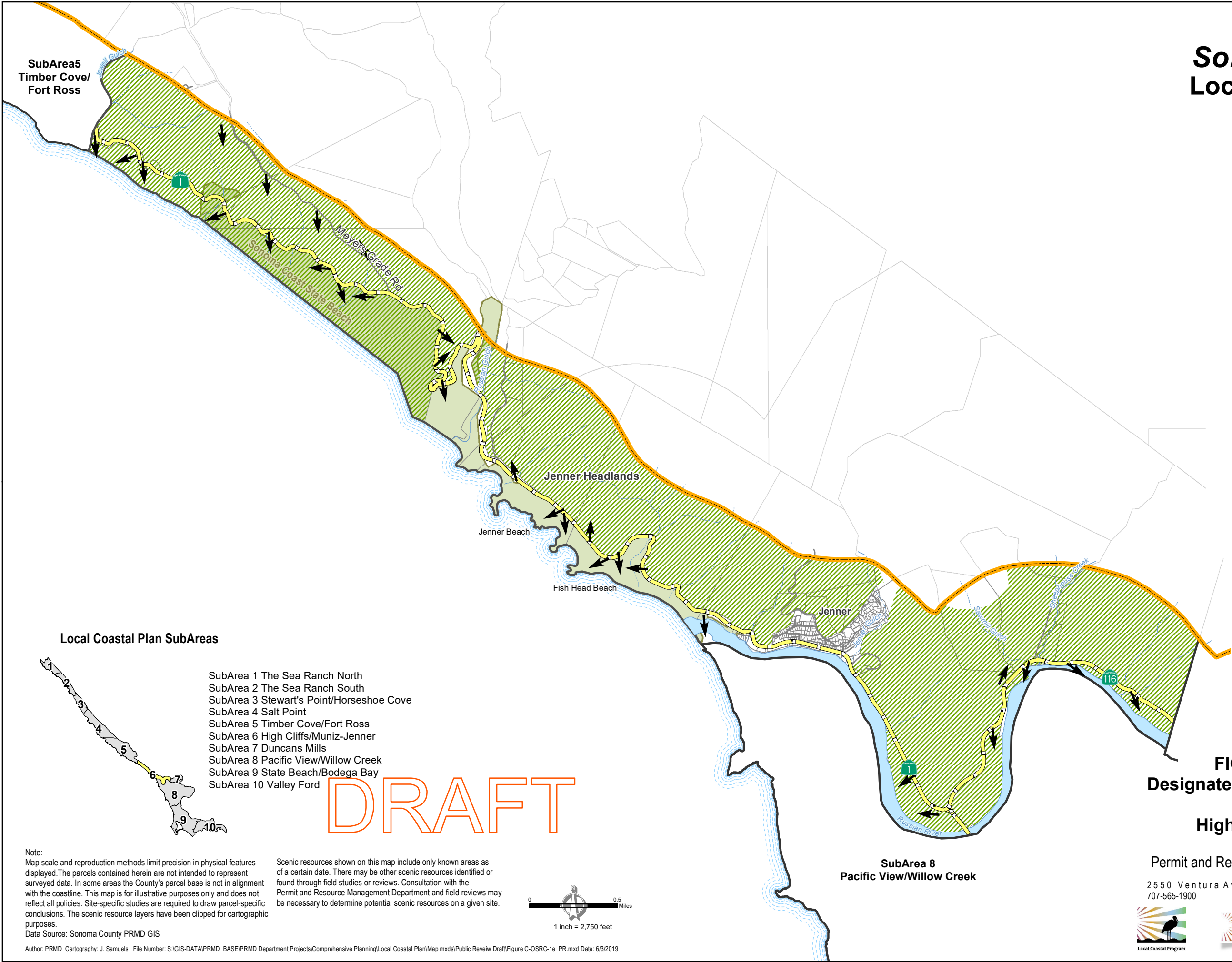

Timber Cove/Fort Ross

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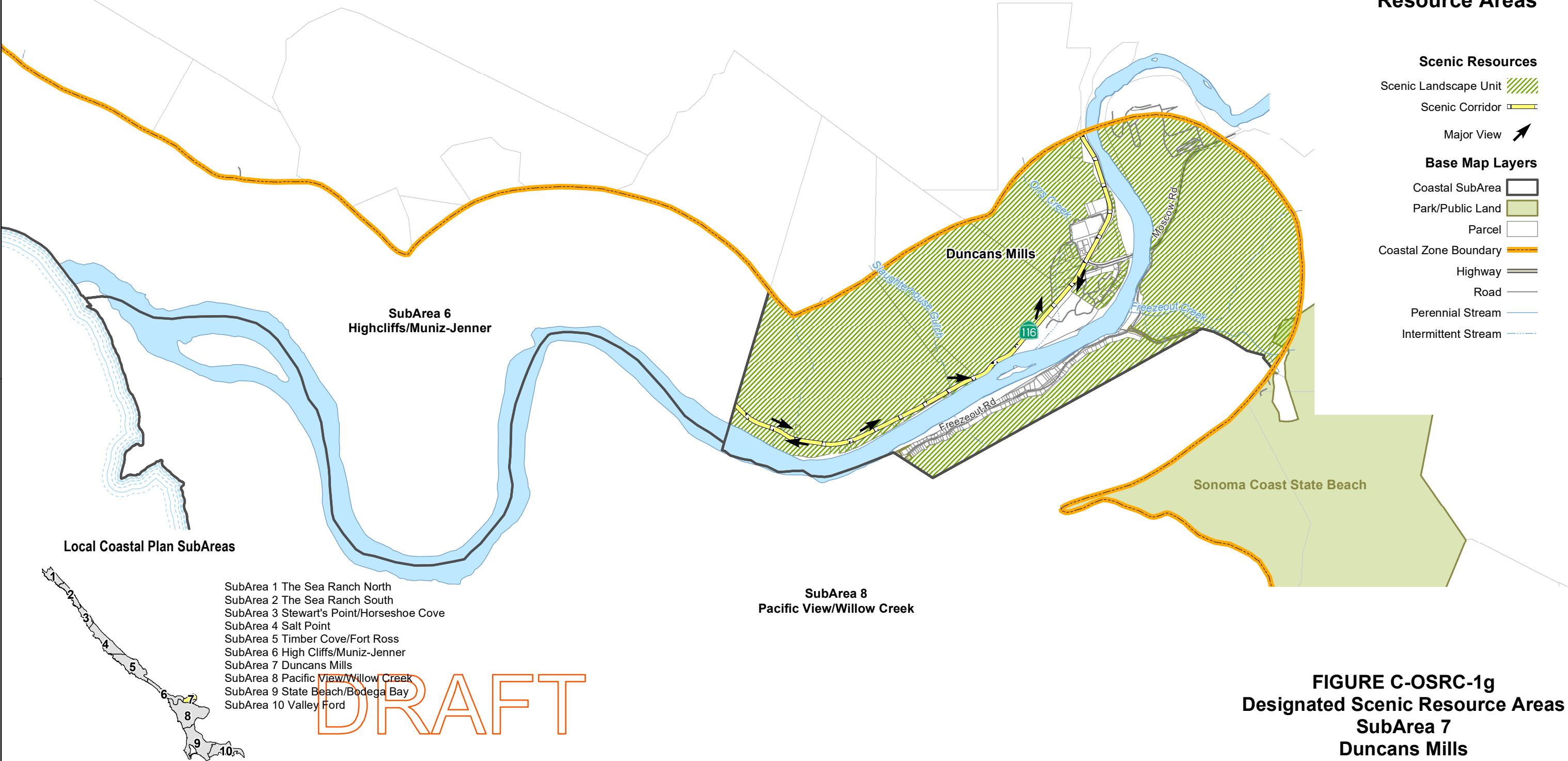

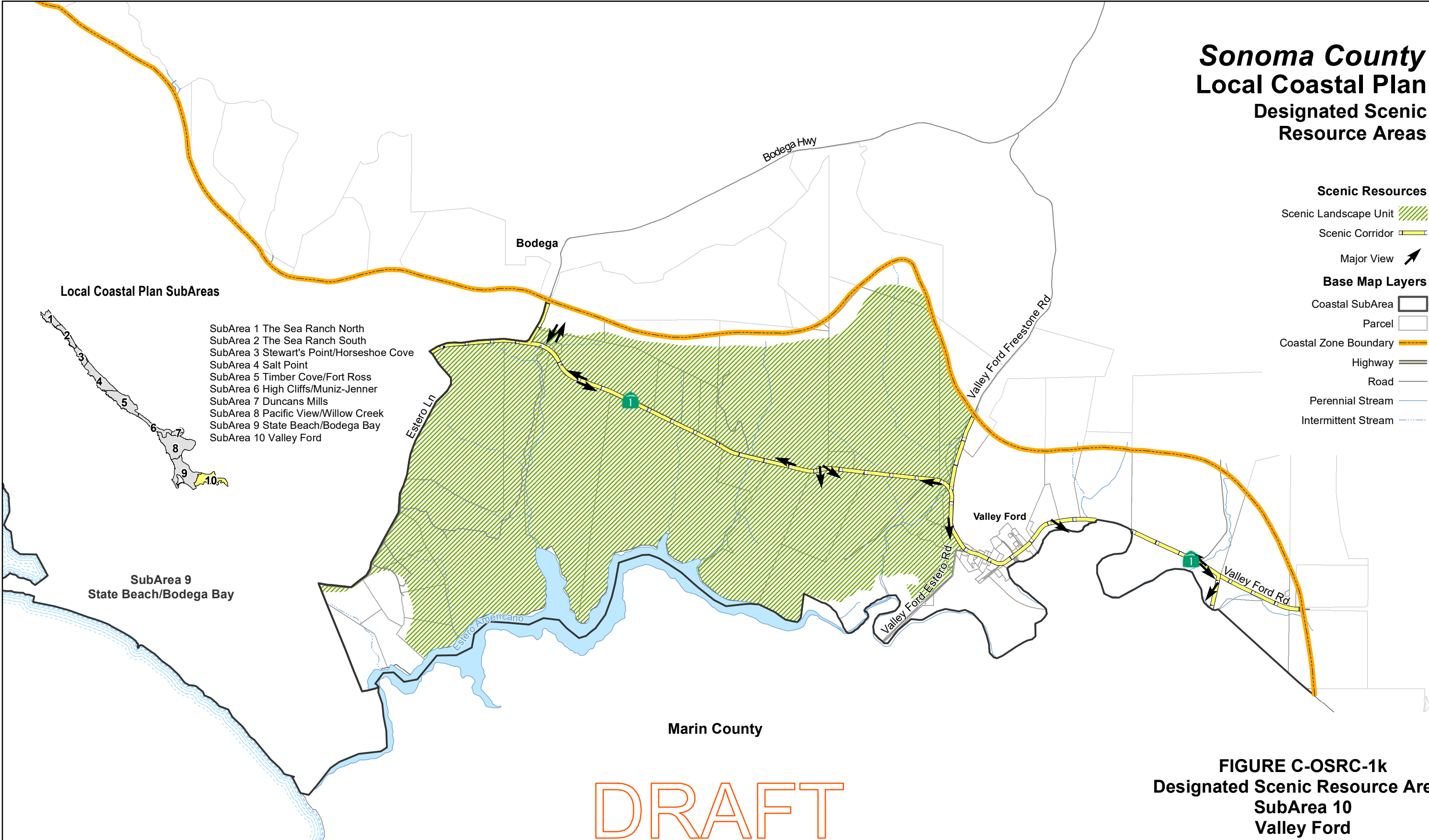


FIGURE C-OSRC-1k
